EXAMINATION

1. Inordinate delay in the University Results.

3. Number of pending results (MU) have increased disproportionately.

VOCATIONAL COURSES

1. Assets of different vocational courses not defined.
2. There is no separate stock register of books for different vocational courses.
3. Systems in computer lab of MBA, MCA and BCA are needed to be replaced rather spending huge sum on AMC.
4. Faculty from MCA be given the responsibility of the Computer lab for its maintenance.
5. No record is maintained in the Computer Lab about the users
6. Payment of guest faculty /class in the vocational courses is not dignified. It must be revised.

INFRASTRUCTURE

1. Inadequate number of class rooms.
2. ICT facilities inadequate.
3. Zoology Lab which is running from old building requires urgent major renovation.
4. Chemistry Lab is vulnerable from northern side.
5. College play field is vulnerable to outsiders.
